Weller House residents may move in beginning Monday, August 21 at 10:00am. Weller residents will pick up keys from the Kilcawley House front desk. Our houses open to freshmen residents living in Lyden and Kilcawley Houses on Friday, August 25 from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. All of our houses open to freshmen on Saturday, August 26. We recommend to our upperclass residents that they move in on Sunday, August 27. Move-in on Saturday & Sunday is scheduled from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. During these times, it is guaranteed that Housing & Residence Life staff and Move-In Crew members will be available to help residents move in and start the check-in process. If you are unable to check in at your scheduled time, please call us to make an appointment to check in at another time.

Room Assignments

A Room Assignment Card is enclosed in this mailing. This card will give you your YSU address and phone number. Every effort is made to assign students to the House they prefer. Returning residents had the opportunity to select their rooms this spring. New residents are assigned in the order that they paid their room reservation fee.

Assignment Changes

If there is a problem with your assignment, please let us know. Some assignments will change before the start of fall semester, primarily due to cancellations. If an assignment changes, we will let you know as quickly as we can. At the start of the semester, if your assigned roommate does not show up, you will be re-assigned to another room or will receive a new roommate.

Roommates

On your Room Assignment Card is the name and contact information of your assigned roommate. If you have two names, this means you have been assigned to live in a triple room. If you and a friend requested each other, Housing & Residence Life's first priority was to place you together. In some cases, this meant placing you and your roommate in the House that was your second preference. If you requested a roommate and you were not placed with him/her, there is a good chance we do not have an application on file for the requested roommate and wanted to go ahead and place you. Housing & Residence Life encourages you to call the person you wanted to live with and ask if they sent the application and room reservation fee to Housing & Residence Life. We will try to accommodate your requests as best we can. For all students who filled out the Personal Profile and sent it to us, we utilized that in the matching process. Not Coming?

If you decide not to attend YSU or if you decide not to live with us you must notify University Housing. No one from YSU will notify our office. It is much easier and less disruptive to do this now rather than after you have arrived. We appreciate your assistance.

Students who need to check in prior to August 25th may be allowed to do so for a minimal fee. The charge is \$22.00 a night. If you are coming back early to work or to participate in an extracurricular activity, check with your supervisor...many programs will pay this fee for you.
